SUBJ: Parking for State Race

(REVISED – Changes in red) Aloha,

Public Parking for the 2011 State Race will be at the Lahaina Civic Center. We have secured a lot there and will be running 3 shuttle buses all day (from 6:00a.m. to 6:30 p.m. or 1 hour after the race ends, whichever is earlier). Both lots open at 6:00 a.m. and will close one hour after the last race or 7:00 p.m. whichever is earlier.

The lot is located at the Lahaina Civic Center —directly behind the Civic Center itself. The entrance to the parking area is on the Kaanapali (North) side of the Civic center. Turn mauka from Honoapiilani Hwy onto Leialii Parkway (the Lahaina Post office is right on the corner). This is the stoplight before the race site if you are coming from Lahaina. To get to the parking area turn left onto Kaaahi St. (before entering the Villages of Leialii), and follow that road until it ends (you will continue on past the police station, cross thru the intersection, go past the fire station and go straight up the hill to the parking lot). There will be signs posted.

Parking at Hanakao'o is by permit only – for officials and vendors. Each club entering a crew will receive one parking pass for Hanakao'o at the coaches meeting. You may drop off paddlers at the site.

There will be no left turn into or out of Hanakao'o. If coming from the South (Lahaina Side) you must pass the site and turn around at Kaanapali (the next traffic light); then you can enter by making a right turn off the highway. When leaving if you wish to go north, turn south (right) and turn around at the Civic Center/Post office (the next light).

Also, because of the limited space, we will not be able to accommodate large buses at the site. If you have charted a large bus, your bus can drop off at the rear entrance of the Hyatt Regency Maui (which is immediately North of the race site)

Any vehicles parked on the shoulder of highway will be ticketed by Police.
